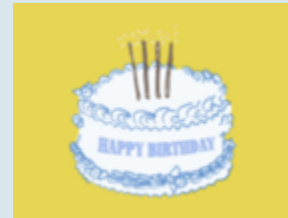
## Sine Die Upcoming
