[HB2459 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) – Creates a rule that any state employee or officer cannot make more than 10x the amount the lowest paid employee earns

[HB2739 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) – Allows for a person with limited English proficiency request a car registration card that shows their language status

[HB2748 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) – Prohibits AI from using professional nursing certifications like RN, NP, or CNA

[HB2811 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) – Creates Oregon’s Imagination Library which provides 1 free book per month to children

[HB3054 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) Creates a rental cap (lots of testimony)

[HB3647 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) Requires gas stations to post gasoline prices

[SB1126 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) Creates mandatory recess

[SB210 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) Remove Oregon’s Vote-By-Mail program, move to in-person voting (most testified on bill in session)

[SB944 2025 Regular Session - Oregon Legislative Information System](#) – Changes independent living requirements for foster kids

2024 REGULAR SESSION

[SB 1571](#) – Requires disclosure of AI in campaign communications.

Lots of testimony, much of it easy to understand and with good critiques.

2023 SESSION

[SB 3](#) (Enrolled) – Requires students to complete one half-credit of higher education and career path skills and one half credit of financial education as requirements for high school

[SB 424](#) (Enrolled) – Prohibits post-secondary institutions that are based in Oregon from refusing to provide transcript to current or former student because student owes debt to institution

[SB 437](#) (A-Engrossed) – Allows specified production of food in planned communities by lot owners and their tenants

[SB 466](#) (Introduced) – Allows person taking certain nuisance game mammals to offer meat to charitable organization or retain meat

[SB 479](#) (Enrolled) – allows donation of meat (similar to above but this is more about meat coming from a licensed inspection facility)

[SB 543](#) (enrolled) – Prohibits food vendor from using polystyrene foam containers in sales of prepared food.

[SB 545](#) (Enrolled) – Directs OHA to adopt rules allowing restaurants to allow consumers to fill consumer-owned container with food

[SB 611](#) (Enrolled) – Caps annual rent increases for residential tenancies (tons of testimony on both sides for this one, easy to ID the stakeholders)

[SB 907](#) (Enrolled) – Prohibits employer from retaliating or discriminating against employee or prospective employee who, in good faith and with no reasonable alternative, refuses exposure arising from hazardous condition at place of employment (Good testimony, good analysis possible on pros/cons)

2022 SESSION
